The tour starts at the Kallinikeio Museum, followed by halloumi cheese making at Father Kallinikos' house. The visit culminates with a visit to the restored Flour Mill. 01. Bus transfers are not included. Public bus from Larnaka Central Bus Station leaves at 09:55 (drop off outside Voroklini Lake Watchtower; opposite the petrol station, at 10:10). If you are staying in Pyla - Voroklini area, get bus 424 or 425, stop at Voroklini Fire Station and walk 10 minutes towards Voroklini - the lake is on the left. Bus 419 departs from Voroklini Lake Watchtower at 12:45 & 13:55.
02. Bus transfers are not included. Public bus from Larnaka Central Bus Station leaves at 10:45. Departs from Mazotos at 12:40 & 15:40 – Bus No. 407.
03. Bus transfers are not included. Public bus from Larnaka Central Bus Station leaves at 11:00. Departs from Athienou at 14:15 & 16:15 – Bus No. 415.
